## A LIST OF SUBJECT AREAS NECESSARY FOR PASSING THE THEORETICAL PART OF THE EXAMINATION FOR FREE PILOTAGE

- 1. General description of the pilotage area, port rules of the port concerned.
- 2. Knowledge of the navigational conditions in the pilotage area, use of means of communication and knowledge of mandatory reporting procedures.
- 3. International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (COLREG 1972).
- 4. Other requirements in the area concerned for ensuring maritime safety and prevention of pollution of the marine environment.
- 5. Valid international maritime conventions and relevant legislation in force in the Republic of Estonia.
- 6. The aids to navigation system in the area and characteristics of the aids.
- 7. Fairways, anchorage areas, shoals and shallows, etc. and their description.
- 8. Communication and reception and transmission of navigational information in the area concerned.
- 9. Traffic separation schemes and the Vessel Traffic Service area.
